The Day of Dance (Reel 4x32)

(A dance for four couples in a longways set of four)

Written for the Children's Day of Dance held on May 28th 2011 in Dumfries which was led by Louise Macdougall and organised by the Dumfries Branch of the RSCDS with children's class teacher Jo Oliver.

- **1-4** 1^{st} and 3^{rd} couples, right hands joined lead down the middle of the set, 2^{nd} and 4^{th} couples step up on bars 3 and 4.
- **5-8** 1^{st} and 3^{rd} couples lead up and finish with the 1^{st} couple back to back between the 2^{nd} couple, (1^{st} man facing 2^{nd} man and 1^{st} lady facing 2^{nd} lady) and 3^{rd} couple back to back between 4^{th} couple (3^{rd} man facing 4^{th} man and 3^{rd} lady facing 4^{th} lady).
- **9-16** All dance right shoulder reels of 4 across the dance, finishing back where the reel started but 1^{st} and 3^{rd} couples turn left hand (instead of passing left shoulder) to finish on own side facing up.
- **17-22** 1st couple cast to 4th place and 3^{rd} couple dance up to the top of the set and cast to 2^{nd} place.
- **23-24** All set
- **25-32** All four couples turn their partner with the right hand and set twice.

Repeat from new positions.

Although this is a 4 couple dance, it could be danced in a 3 couple set with just the 1^{st} couple dancing down the middle, and the 1^{st} and 2^{nd} couples dancing the reel. 1^{st} couple would cast to 3^{rd} place and a new 1^{st} couple would start the next time through.
